RAM's FREE 2-day clinic set for this weekend

Free dental, vision and medical services coming to Glendale, Calif.

GLENDAL, Calif. (Oct. 25, 2022) – Remote Area Medical – RAM® – a major nonprofit provider of pop-up clinics delivering free, quality dental, vision and medical care to those in need – will hold a free, two-day clinic this weekend, Nov. 5-6. RAM will be set up at the Pacific Community Center, located at 501 South Pacific Ave., Glendale, CA 91204, for two days only. This clinic is in collaboration with the 11th Annual Glendale Health Festival and the Armenian American Medical Society.

All RAM services are free, and no ID is required. Free dental, vision and medical services will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis. **Clinic doors open at 9 a.m.**

Due to time constraints, patients should be prepared to choose between DENTAL and VISION services. Medical services are offered, in addition to dental or vision services, free to every patient attending the clinic. All patients must undergo a COVID-19 CDC question screening before entering the clinic. For more information, to donate or to volunteer, please visit www.ramusa.org or call 865-579-1530.

Additional Information:

- Services available at the free RAM clinic include dental cleanings, dental fillings, dental extractions, dental X-rays, eye exams, glaucoma testing, eyeglass prescriptions, eyeglasses made on-site, women's health exams and general medical exams. Free, take-home colon cancer screening test kits, cancer screenings, medication management, hearing tests, flu & Covid-19 vaccines, glucose & cholesterol screenings, mental health education, addiction awareness, nutrition education, bone-density screenings, on-site drug disposal, weight management education and more will also be available.
- In some situations outside RAM's control, such as inclement weather, volunteer cancellations or other circumstances, the parking lot may open earlier or a smaller number of patients may be served. RAM encourages everyone who would like services, especially dental services, to arrive as early as possible. Clinic closing time may vary based on each service area's daily capacity.
